Mediation & Arbitration Rates:

- 2 Party Case: \$250 per party per hour
- 3 Party Case: \$200 per party per hour
- 4+ Party Case: \$175 per party per hour

Minimum Fees:

- Half Day – 3 hours, or the amount of time reserved if more than 3 hours
- Full Day – 6 hours, or the amount of time reserved if more than 6 hours

MEDIATION/ARBITRATION CANCELLATION POLICY
